ORDER

After careful review of all information before it, including information received from the West Virginia Medical Professionals Health Program, the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine has determined that Respondent is in compliance with his Continuing Recovery Care Agreement and his return to the practice of osteopathic medicine and surgery will not pose a risk to members of the public.

It is therefore ORDERED that Respondent's license to practice osteopathic medicine in West Virginia, Board-issued license # 1905, is to be restored to active status once all requirements for license renewal have been met.

It is further ORDERED that Respondent shall continue to abide by all remaining terms of the Consent Order between Respondent and the Board that went into effect on September 14, 2017.
