## ORDER

After careful review of all information before it, including information received from the West Virginia Medical Professionals Health Program, the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine ("the Board") hereby finds the following:

On May 31, 2018, the Board Ordered that Respondent's license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state of West Virginia, Board-issued license number 1905, be restored to active status, terminating the suspension ordered by the Consent Order that went into effect on September 14, 2017 (Complaint No. 2017-14), and ordering that the Respondent continue to abide by the remaining terms of that Consent Order.

The Board further finds that the September 14, 2017, Consent Order, referenced above, contains terms that make a previous Agreed Order between the Respondent and the Board, that went into effect on March 14, 2017 (Complaint No. 2016-18), redundant.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the Agreed Order between the Respondent and the Board, that went into effect on March 14, 2017 (Complaint No. 2016-18), be **TERMINATED**.
