



**WV BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE**

**Waiver Form**

**Beginning May 1, 2014, unless a physician has completed a Board-certified waiver attesting that he or she has not prescribed, administered or dispensed a controlled substance during the entire previous reporting period, every physician shall complete a minimum of three (3) hours of drug diversion training and best practice prescribing of controlled substances training, approved by the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine, during the previous reporting period. These three (3) hours shall be part of the 32 total hours of CME required and not three (3) additional CME hours for license renewal.
